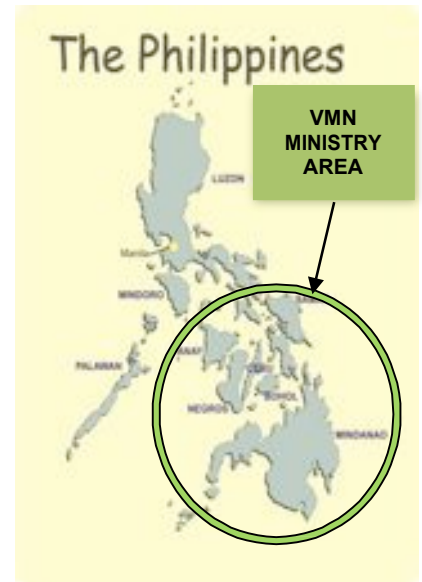

PC NEEDED FOR DAVAO TEAM'S VIDEO EDITING WORK

In 1996, VVMi joined forces with *Overseas Missionary Fellowship (OMF)* to start the beginnings of *Vernacular Media Network (VMN)* on the southern Philippines island of Mindanao. Since its start, VMN has made and shown Christian videos in many of the various Manobo languages of Mindanao, and occasionally in Cebuano, the regional trade language. VMN has at least 5 ministry teams working around Mindanao. One of these teams has been pushing outwards and is now working with and encouraging local churches on the barely-reached islands of Leyte and Samar, as well as on some other islands north of Mindanao.

Over the years, VMN's indigenously made vernacular videos have been very effective in sharing the truths of God's Word with the people of the southern Philippines. The VMN Production Department hopes to be very busy in the next 5 years making new movies for the indigenous peoples in VMN's expanding ministry area, but also translating and dubbing the children's Bible story video series, *Deditos*, which is produced by Viña, another VVMi partner. These efforts will require a dependable and speedy computer. The team has concluded that a PC suited for video editing is the best solution long-term for meeting the demands of the new editing team, both as far as processing power and price.

This project will provide funding for the purchase in the Philippines of a new PC tower and monitor. This equipment will allow continued expansion of VMN's overall ministry, especially through the Cebuano trade language, which has some 13 million speakers. Cebuano will also allow VMN to work amongst several minority language groups and move further into new ministry areas.
