FACILITY: AN ESSENTIAL PART THE VVM-CMI'S MINISTRY

Vernacular Video Ministry – Church Mobilization Initiative (VVM-CMI), headquartered in Baguio City, Luzon, Philippines, has been VVM-I's ministry partner from the beginning. VVM-CMI has been "mobilizing" local church groups – empowering them with video and Scripture tools – in the mountain provinces of northern Luzon since mid-2008. Starting in 2010, the VVM-CMI expanded to the region of Palawan and other islands southwest of Luzon. Now, in 2016, eighteen (18) active mobilized partner groups with hundreds of indigenous Christians are working across language and denominational lines for the purpose of sharing the Gospel through heart language videos and Scripture. New Bible study groups and church plants are a normal result as local churches utilize media tools to assist their mission efforts.

Experience has shown the necessity of VVM-CMI's having a reliable and accessible office facility for accomplishing the ministry God has given them. It is indisputable the investments in equipment, supplies, and vernacular Bibles need to be kept secure, dry, and available for use by all ministry staff at a central location. Besides being used for storage, the space also serves as a studio for video and audio productions as well as the main hub for email and postal mail communications. Additionally, the facility provides a location for many important events: staff meetings; training seminars; a place for hosting meetings with other organizations; and the like.

The main VVM-CMI headquarters facility is a rented 3-story structure. Even though the VVM-CMI's ministry partnerships have expanded to other areas of the Philippines, the current location remains strategic due to the large number of VVM-CMI partners in northern Luzon, and because of the relatively cooler climate afforded by Baguio City's mountain location that makes it a desirable place for holding meetings. The current facility has two guest rooms for visitors and ministry partners (such as church lay leaders or VVM-I Mission Volunteers) traveling from far away. These accommodations are a very cost-effective and convenient asset.
